

GENERAL LIBRARY RULES AND REGULATIONS

- o Library Patrons should always carry their ID cards while visiting the Library. In case, a student does not produce it, he/she may not be permitted to use the library facilities.
- o All students/research scholars visiting the library shall deposit their belongings and bags at the property/belongings counter.
- o Eatables and beverages are prohibited to bring in the Library.
- o All should maintain strict silence inside the library, engaging in discussion/conversation/group studyinside the reading area is strictly prohibited.
- o All users while leaving the library must show all books, papers, folders, etc. in their possession before exit.
- o Users should not mark, cut, deface, mutilate or damage library book(s) and other resources. If anyone is found doing so, he/she will be charged the full replacement cost of the book(s) or resource. Books borrowed should be protected from rain, dust and insects etc..
- o The library keeps the right to call back any issued book(s)/item at any time.
- o Books, journals, etc. taken for reading room from the shelves, if not required for reference, should let on the table nearest to them. Students should not try to re-shelve the books themselves.
- o There will be overdue charges of Rs. 5/- per book per day after the due date.
- o Mobiles phones are to be kept on silent mode inside the library reading halls to maintain dignified silence.

Galgotias University's library services are now fully automated and functional, by using the KOHA library management software and RFID technology.

The Web OPAC of the Galgotias University Library allows you to search the library's collections using a variety of methods, including subject, title, and author searches, as well as check the status of book availability in the library. It also allows you to view your borrowing history.

- An RFID-equipped library will be able to check out books and other items that haven't been checked out. The devices are installed at self-service kiosks, with additional readers installed in the security gates near the entrances and exits. These devices detect books or other media that weren't checked out before leaving the premises.
- ➤ We are now offering your library visitors a modern and integrated experience with RFID technology, similar to how library patrons borrow, return, and renew items at our self-check kiosk.
- ➤ Patron Traffic Counter (PTC) supports us in replacing paper registers at entry/exit locations with electronic authentication devices, as well as providing real-time information.

OUR E-DATABASES

The Knimbus platform has been chosen to enable complete access to the Galgotias University Library's subscribed electronic resources. It allows users to access content 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, from anywhere and on any device.



The term "Open Educational Resources," or OER, describes freely accessible online learning materials in the form of texts, videos, or other digital formats. All materials on this website are free for viewing, teaching, and research purposes.

eLearning and OER

Over the last few years, India has been steadily improving its educational system through OER and e-learning. This has brought many advantages to the educational system. Starting with the 2020–21 budgets, the government has created a new education policy emphasizing the importance of online education. The E-learning market in India is projected to expand by 15.64 percent by the end of 2020, reaching \$48 billion. A version of e-learning involves both technology and a variety of pedagogies that can be used to teach and learn. Students can also benefit from OER as a pedagogical tool. Free open educational resources are a fundamental benefit of OER. Besides taking classes online, students have access to a wide range of resources.

OER sources: Online repositories host the most open educational resources. They keep and manage the data stored in these repositories. OER sources can be classified according to the types of resources and repositories they use.
